

Prof. Wang Lixun

Prof. Wang Lixun is a Professor in the Department of Linguistics and Modern Language Studies at the Education University of Hong Kong (EdUHK). He is Associate Dean (International Engagement) of the Faculty of Humanities, Acting Head of the Department of Linguistics and Modern Language Studies, Associate Director of Global Research Institute for Finnish Education, and Associate Co-Director of Global Institute for Emerging Technologies at the EdUHK. He obtained his PhD from the University of Birmingham in the UK. He has published 5 books and over 60 journal articles and book chapters in areas such as corpus linguistics, computer-assisted language learning, and multilingual education. He is the author of “Introduction to Language Studies” (2011, Pearson) and co-author of “Academic Writing in Language and Education Programmes” (2011, Pearson), “Trilingual Education in Hong Kong Primary Schools” (2019, Springer), “Identity, Motivation, and Multilingual Education in Asian Contexts” (2020, Bloomsbury), and “Is English an Asian Language?” (2021, Cambridge University Press). He is editor-in-chief of the Springer book series Multilingual Education, and 12 books have been published under his editorship.
