Dr LIANG Yuan joined The Education University of Hong Kong in 2013 and is an Associate Professor in the Department of Chinese Language Studies. Dr LIANG obtained her BA and MA in Chinese Language and Literature from Peking University and PhD in Linguistics from The University of Hong Kong. Prior to joining The Education University of Hong Kong, Dr LIANG was an Associate Professor in the Department of Chinese Language and Literature of Shenzhen University. Her research interests include Chinese linguistics and education. She has published extensively in her field and invited to give presentations at international conferences and seminars. She has a solid track record in securing research grants and currently is leading research projects on Chinese character writing performance and strategies, language contact, language use and attitudes in GBA, and translanguaging in Chinese language classrooms. Dr LIANG has developed and coordinated a number of undergraduate and postgraduate programs. Currently she is the program leader of the MA (in teaching Chinese as an international language) program. She has also been actively involved in community service, including the Associate Editor-in-chief of International Journal of Chinese Language Education, Subject Committee Member of HKEAA, and Deputy Chairperson of the Chinese Language Festival Association.
