Dr. Wang Lixun is an Associate Professor in the Department of Linguistics and Modern Language Studies at the Education University of Hong Kong. He obtained his PhD from the University of Birmingham in the UK. His research interests include linguistics and multilingual education. He has published in areas such as corpus linguistics, computerassisted language learning, and multilingual education, in reputable journals such as Computer-Assisted Language Learning, Language Learning and Technology, and International Journal of Bilingual Education and Bilingualism. He is the author of "Introduction to Language Studies" (2011) and co-author of "Academic Writing in Language and Education Programmes" (2011). In 2014-16, he completed a large-scale project (funded by the prestigious General Research Fund under Hong Kong Research Grants Council) on trilingual education in Hong Kong primary schools, and his new book 'Trilingual Education in Hong Kong Primary Schools' will be published in 2018. In the past years, Dr. Wang has assumed key responsibilities in departmental management in various capacities, such as a core member of the Department's Senior Management Team. He has also developed and coordinated a number of undergraduate programmes, and currently he is the programme leader of the BEd(English Language) programme, and the BA(language Studies) & BEd(English Language) double degree programme. He has been actively involved in various community services, such as serving as an External Reviewer for SCOLAR (The Standing Committee on Language Education and Research)'s Research and Development Projects. In 2014, he won the President's Award for Outstanding Performance in Teaching in the Hong Kong Institute of Education (now the Education University of Hong Kong).

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
